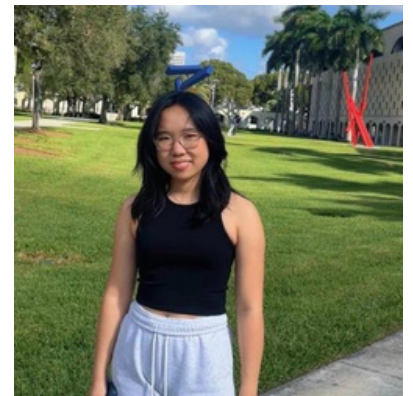

Our Vision

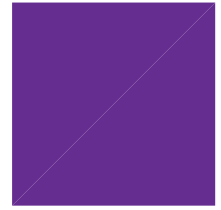
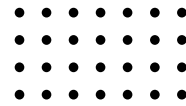

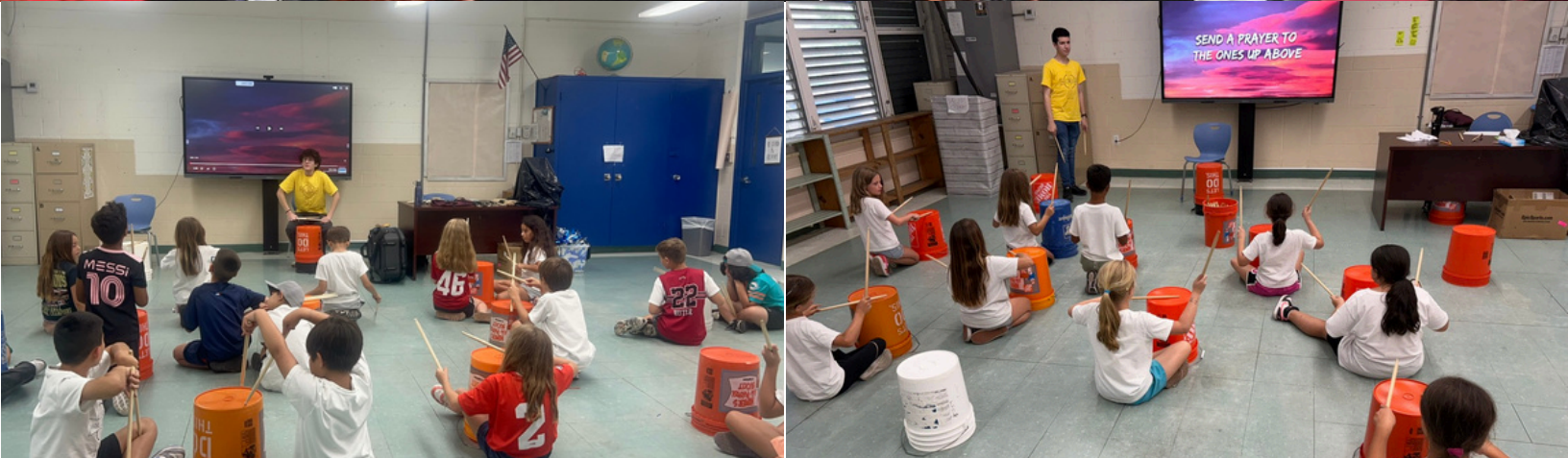
HOW WE AIM “THE NEW”

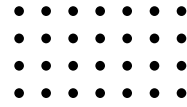
The Outcomes

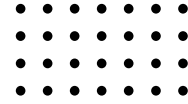

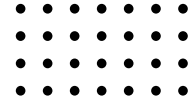
